



MAXFIELD'S DIY GUIDE: WATERING PLANTS

“Plants need more water than we do and at times can be more finicky about drinking it.”



TIME REQUIRED:

APPROXIMATELY 10 - 20 MINUTES



TOOLS REQUIRED:

WATERING CAN OR HOSE

- Add 2-3 inches of Maxfield's Planting Mix to conserve up to 75% of water.

- Plan to water mid-afternoon everyday. It's safe to say the best time to water is 2 hours before sunset.

- Check moisture before watering.

- Look for mildew and remove leaves with affected areas.

- Aim to water directly in the soil, below the leaves, to avoid creating conditions for mildew.

- Drooping is a sign of lack of water. Still wait to water “droopy” plants until mid-afternoon. Make sure when you do water them to water them in thoroughly.
